STATE VS NATIONAL **ESTIMATES OF HEALTH INSURANCE** COVERAGE

The National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) recently released a National Health Statistics Report, which presents state-level estimates of health insurance coverage using data from the 2020 National Health Interview Survey (NHIS).

This infographic details state-level trends in public coverage, private coverage, and those without health insurance coverage for nonelderly adults age 18-64.

Notes: Statistically significant differences at 95% confidence level.

Estimates for some states were suppressed for certain types of coverage because the estimates did not meet NCHS's standards for statistical reliability. As a result, public coverage and private coverage data are presented for 32 states and DC and uninsured for 27 states.

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




