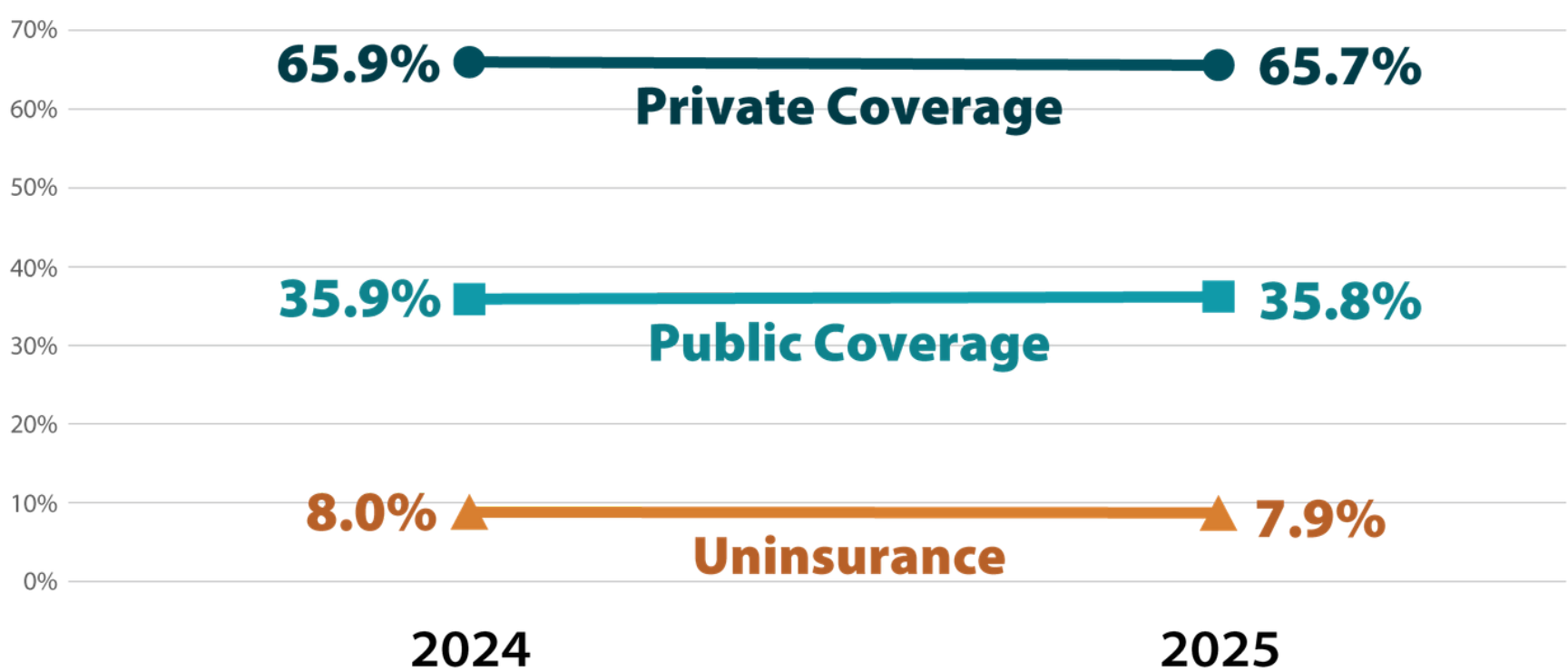


NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE LANDSCAPE IN 2025

Nonelderly Adults

11.0%
of nonelderly adults were
uninsured in 2025.

74.5%
of nonelderly adults had
private coverage in 2025.

public coverage in 2025.

Elderly Adults

0.9%
of elderly adults were
uninsured in 2025.

No change from 2024

41.5%
of elderly adults had
private coverage in 2025.

2.8 percentage-point
decrease from 2024

94.3%
of elderly adults had
public coverage in 2025.

Notes: All changes are tested at the 90% confidence level.
All estimates come from the 2025 and 2026 Current Population Survey Annual Social and Economic Supplements, which provide data for years 2024 and 2025, respectively.
Uninsured estimates represent individuals with no health insurance coverage for the entire calendar year.
Estimates of health insurance coverage type represent individuals with that type of coverage at any point during the calendar year. Types of health insurance coverage are not mutually exclusive, meaning that individuals may be counted in more than one category if they switch coverage types during the calendar year.
