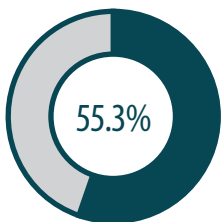

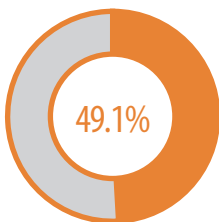
HIGH-DEDUCTIBLE HEALTH PLANS

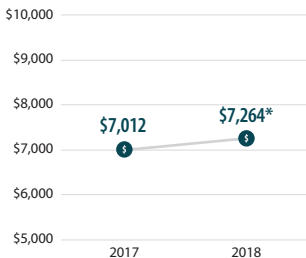

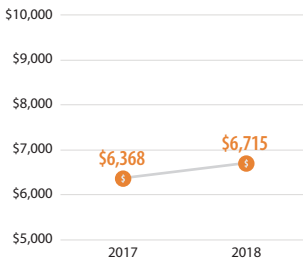
