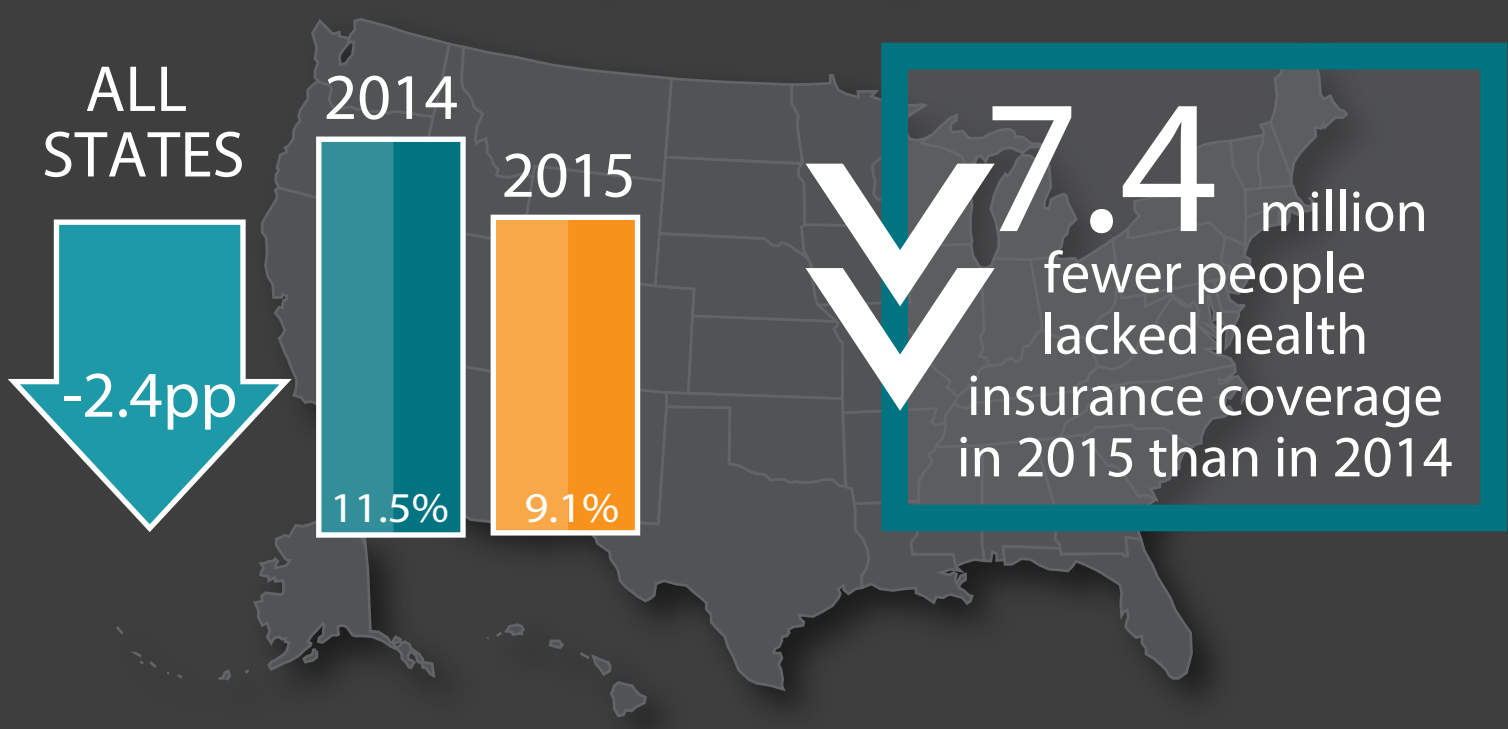

PERCENT UNINSURED AT TIME OF INTERVIEW (ALL AGES)

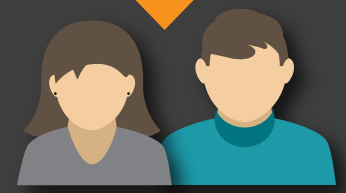


2014 - 2015 UNINSURANCE RATE CHANGES
