

BACKGROUND

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) has made significant changes in health insurance coverage and health care systems across the U.S.

States responsible for implementing many of the key measures

- Expansion of Medicaid eligibility
- Creation of health insurance exchanges

State program administrators and policymakers need reliable state-level data

NATIONAL HEALTH INTERVIEW SURVEY

The NHIS is a key data source for monitoring population health in the U.S.

Provides a rich set of policy-relevant variables and changes to survey in recent years facilitate evaluation of the impact of the ACA

State identifiers are not available on public use files; access restricted to a Research Data Center (RDC)

Expand the role of NHIS in helping states implement, monitor, and evaluate health reform

Link public use and restricted data Integrated Health Interview Series (IHIS) – harmonized NHIS produced by the Minnesota Population Center and SHADAC

Provide state-level estimates of health insurance coverage and health care access, affordability, and utilization through SHADAC's Data Center (http://datacenter.shadac.org)

Sample weights do not account for state population totals and characteristics

Small sample sizes, especially if using sample adult/child measures or focusing on subgroups within a state
